



Scholarships for attending the 2019 Gestalt Research Conference

As part of GANZ's strategy to support the development of Gestalt Research, GANZ will fund two \$150 USD scholarships towards the cost of the tickets for 2019 Gestalt Research Conference in Santiago. The International Gestalt Research Application will match funding provided by GANZ, which together will cover the total cost of the conference ticket. The Scholarship does not cover costs of flights or accommodation.

Selection Criteria

Applicants must be current financial members of GANZ.

Applicants must satisfy at least one of the following criteria:

- Existing record of research in Gestalt therapy;
- Demonstrated and expressed interest in conducting or organising such research; and
- Financial need (that is, the extent to which the award of the scholarship will enable the applicant to attend the conference, where otherwise they might have been unable to do so).

Exclusion criteria:

- GANZ Council members and their immediate family members are not eligible

Transparency:

- Applicant must disclose professional or personal relationships with GANZ Council members

Applications should contain:

- Covering letter addressing the selection criteria;
- Resume setting out relevant qualifications, work experience, research record and publications.

Applications close on 28-Dec-18 and the successful applicants will be determined by the GANZ Council.

The successful applicant will be required to write a short report on the conference for distribution in the GANZ Newsletter
